The planning and organisational roles of managers are well understood. However, on this programme you will gain invaluable insight into what it takes to become a leader and the qualities of vision, inspiration, motivation and empowering people that this role embodies.

You will:

- Make the connection between leadership theory and the role of a leader;
- Learn to reflect on your own practice as you progress through the various themes which are built into the programme;
- Develop a keen awareness of various leadership topics including leadership roles & theories, motivation, setting and communicating direction, and emotional intelligence;
- Attain a nationally recognised qualification awarded by the Institute of Leadership and Management (ILM).

Who is it for?


Our L5 Leadership Award is aimed at anyone in a position of responsibility, who is looking to develop and strengthen their leadership skills, practice, and awareness.

Programme content and duration

The structure and overall duration of this programme is flexible and determined by the group or organisation. However, we recommend that the programme is completed in 6-months minimum. The programme includes:

- Assessing your own leadership capability and performance;
- Formal written assessment;
- 2-hours per week on private study, reading, practical work-based activities, assessment preparation.

 This programme is accredited by the Institute of Leadership and Management. The ILM is a professional body with a worldwide network of over 2,000 accredited centres providing flexible and practical management development programmes which are quality assured to ILM's standards.
