During the afternoon session you will be invited to participate in a facilitated discussion workshop. The purpose behind this session is designed to:

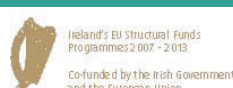
- Identify the most interesting components of BioMara for you and your organisation
